GDPR Changes

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) demands greater accountability and transparency from organizations in how they collect, process and store personal information.

Passwords:

- All new accounts from April 2018 will have a password that changes and users will be prompted to change the password when logging on for the first time.
- All accounts need to have a password champion who will change and keep record of the password.
- S&P Global will have no visibly of the passwords once changed and will direct all users to the assigned password champion to share the passwords.
- Customer care will only accept requests for password changes from the password champion.

The password champion emails a change request to global delivery

Global Delivery change the password and send email to the password champion

The champion logs in with the password sent and is prompted to change S&P Global no longer has any visibility off the changed password

It is the responsibility of the champion to store/share the password with their communit
